

Tennis Rules and Regulations

- 1. All members and guests must register before entering the fitness center/tennis area. Each member must show and scan his/her membership ID.**
2. Members, their spouse/significant other and dependent children, who qualify for membership privileges as stated in the Club Rules & Regulations, may use the outdoor courts without charge. Guests must be accompanied by their member sponsor and will be charged accordingly.
3. Reservations for courts may be made 2 days in advance and will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations may be made Monday through Friday beginning at 5:30am, Saturday and Sunday at 7:00am. For example, a Wednesday court may be reserved on Monday.
4. No reservations shall be for more than one and one-half hours (90 minutes).
5. A player may make only one court reservation per day. A member may make reservations only for themselves and their family.
6. Reserved outdoor and indoor courts will only be held 10 minutes past the reservation time when others are waiting.
7. The member is responsible for canceling, in advance, a reserved court that will not be used. An indoor fee will be charged for “no-shows” on indoor courts. Please note the following:
 - a. Morning courts must be canceled no later than 5:00pm on the day before the reservation.
 - b. Afternoon and evening courts must be canceled before 8:00am of the reservation day.
 - c. The same cancellation policies apply for lessons.
8. The Tennis Head Professional or the Sports/Fitness Manager shall have final authority on all reservations and other tennis rules.
9. Players shall wear appropriate tennis clothing when using the courts, which includes wearing a shirt at all times. Unacceptable attire shall include but is not limited to: swim suits, halter tops, sports bras, workout outfits and cutoffs. Men may not wear tank tops.
10. Only smooth-soled tennis shoes shall be worn on the courts (no hard-soled running shoes or black-soled shoes are permitted at any time). A \$100 court cleaning fee will be charged if black-soled shoes are worn.
11. Pets and non-playing individuals are not permitted in the court enclosures.
12. No food of any kind may be brought within the tennis court enclosures.
13. Loud, boisterous conduct or profanity will not be tolerated on the courts.
14. Clay tennis courts should be swept and lines cleaned by players after they use the courts.
15. Smoking is not allowed in the indoor court areas.
16. Only alcoholic beverages sold at the Club are allowed on the Club property. It is illegal to bring alcoholic beverages onto the Club property or to remove alcoholic beverages from the Club property.
17. All accidents, regardless of how minor, must be reported to the Supervisor on duty. If appropriate, an accident report must be filed with Cheyenne Mountain Resort Security.

Tennis Guest Information

A guest is a non-member individual who is accompanied by a member for the purpose of playing tennis and/or using other Club facilities.

An adult is charged \$12.00 per day and a junior guest (5 – 17 years old) is charged \$8.00 per day. This fee entitles the guest to use the locker rooms and workout facilities. An additional use fee will be charged for any indoor court used.

Guests are limited to six (6) visits during the summer season (Memorial Day – Labor Day) and may not exceed a total of twelve visits during the year.

A reciprocal guest is a bona fide member of a reciprocating club outside El Paso and Teller counties. Reciprocal guests will be charged the appropriate guest and use fees. A guest of the Cheyenne Mountain Resort may register to play tennis at designated times and shall pay the appropriate tennis use and court fees.
