Aquatics Rules and Regulations

- 1. All members and guest must register before entering the swimming/recreation area. Each member must show and scan his/her membership card.**
2. The Aquatics Manager and the staff on duty shall have full authority to regulate use of the pool area and the lake per the Colorado Health Department guidelines.
3. Members, their spouse and dependent children, who qualify for membership privileges as stated in the Club Rules & Regulations, may use the pools without charge. Guests of members must be accompanied by their member sponsor and will be charged the established fee.
4. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or adult guardian at all times.
5. Day use lockers are issued on a first-come, first-served basis at the time of registration for trade of your member card.
6. The Club is not responsible for loss or theft of personal property.
7. Members and guests are encouraged to bring their own towels. **During busy times, only one (1) towel per day, per member will be provided.**
8. Members are responsible for all towels and keys issued to them, their families and their guests. A \$25.00 charge will be assessed for each lost towel and key.
9. Running, rough play and personal conduct that endangers the safety of any person is not tolerated.
10. Swimming accessories and floatation devices are permitted in the pools only by permission of the staff on duty. Floatation devices are not permitted in the lake. Club and personally owned kick boards are for lap swimming use only.
11. China and/or glass containers are not permitted at the Aquatics Facility at any time.
12. Only alcoholic beverages sold at the Club or Cheyenne Mountain Resort are allowed on Club property. It is illegal to bring alcoholic beverages onto Club property or to remove alcoholic beverages from the Club property.

13. Patio furniture and sun chairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis for your personal use.
14. No pets of any kind are allowed in the pool area, unless for a club sponsored event (Dog Day at the Beach).
15. All accidents, regardless of how minor, must be reported to an Aquatics Staff member.
16. Parent supervision is required for all non-swimmers and children under the age of 13.
17. Parents must sit by the baby pool and supervise their children at all times. There is no lifeguard on duty at the baby pool.
18. Regular diapers are not permitted in the pools or lake. Any non-potty trained child must wear a swim diaper.
19. The Boat Lifeguard provides general lake supervision. It is common for sunfish sailboats to capsize; we will only respond if it appears someone may have been injured or if assistance is needed by the boater. All users of sailboats must display their ability to assemble a sailboat under 15 minutes to utilize one. All members and guests are required to wear approved lifejackets.
20. Smoking is only allowed in a designated smoking section between the indoor pool bubble and the Aquatics Facility building.
21. Groups of 10 or more are required to give 24 hours' notice to use the Aquatics facility. The Aquatics staff will not be available to help with and will not allow the relocation of furniture to accommodate an unplanned group.
22. Pool parties, regardless of how small, must be scheduled through the Country Club Sales Manager in the Club Office. **Food and beverage must be purchased on property.**

Aquatics Area Guest Information

1. A guest is an individual who is sponsored and accompanied by a member for the purpose of using the facilities.
2. The adult daily guest fee is \$12.00 (18 years and older), the junior daily guest fee is \$8.00 (5 – 17 years). Under the age of 5 is complimentary.
3. Guests are limited to six (6) visits during the summer season (Memorial Day - Labor Day) and may not exceed a total of twelve (12) visits during the year.
4. A guest of the Cheyenne Mountain Resort must be registered at the hotel to use the swimming/recreation facilities.

Aquatics Area Locker Rooms

1. Annual lockers are issued on a first-come, first-served basis at the time of registration, and are automatically billed in January. Daily lockers are issued on a first-come, first-served basis for trade of the membership card.
2. For safety and security reasons, unauthorized locker use is prohibited. Unregistered lockers with a personal lock will have the locks removed, and the contents of the locker will be appropriately disposed of. Unregistered use of a locker is prohibited.
3. The Club will not be responsible for loss or theft of personal property.
4. No food or drinks will be allowed in the locker rooms.
5. Children ages 6 years and older must use the gender appropriate locker rooms.

Fishing Rules and Regulations

1. Fishing is permitted with barbless single hook artificial flies, lures, spinners, spoons and bait. Catch and release only. Fishing supplies are to be supplied by the fisherman.
2. Lake fishermen are limited to designated shore fishing areas between 5:30am (7:00am on weekends) and closing time. Designated areas are patrolled. Fishing is not allowed from the golf course.
3. Fishing is not allowed from boats.
4. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests and children.
5. Violation of fishing rules and regulations will result in the loss of fishing privileges.
6. Guest of members who wish only to fish must still pay the appropriate guest fees for the Aquatics Facility.

Boating Rules and Regulations

1. An annual Boat Usage Agreement and Release Form must be signed and will be kept on file at the Aquatics Center. All members and guests using boats must sign the agreement.
2. In order to sail alone, a boater must be able to accurately setup a sailboat on his/her own in a 15 minute allotted time period. In addition, the boater must be at least 58" tall or 18 years of age. Boaters that are not 58" tall may be given permission to boat alone on play kayaks in the small area at the front of the beach in the roped off buoy area. If the boater leaves the roped off area, they may lose permission to boat until they reach 58".
3. Lifejackets must be worn at all times.
4. Boaters must stay in the boats at all times and not stand up.
5. Violation of boating rules and regulations will result in the loss of boating privileges.
